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NOTIFICATION

No. A.12018/45/2023-P&AR (GSW), the 7th August, 2024: In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Mizoram Horticulture Department (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2013 notified in the Mizoram Gazette extraordinary issue number 597 dated 20.11.2013, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Governor of Mizoram hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Horticulture Demonstrator under Horticulture Department, Government of Mizoram namely:-

- Short title and commencement.-
- (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Horticulture Department (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2024.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.-

These rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column I of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

 Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix or pay scale.- The number of the said posts, classification and level in the pay matrix or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in Column 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.-

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Column 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification.-

No person -

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other valid grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of this

Training and Departmental Examination.- Every officials recruited under these rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to

Power to transfer.-

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the State Government, in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any officials so recruited under these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

8. Power to relax.- Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded writing, through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Saving .-

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

- Questions will be designed to test the candidate's knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience as maybe expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to Indian history and culture, Indian polity including the Constitution of India, geography, economy and general science. Questions on Mizo history and culture will also form part of the syllabus.
- 2. General English: Questions will be designed to test the candidate's understanding and knowledge of English language, vocabulary, spelling, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms, sentence completion, phrases and idiomatic use of words etc. There will be questions on comprehension of a passage also.
- 3. Essay writing: Question on essay writing will be designed to test the candidate's grasp of his material, its relevance to the subject chosen, and to his ability to think constructively and to present his ideas logically, constructively and concisely.
- 4. English Comprehension: There will be questions on comprehension of passages also test the vocabulary, grammar, logical thought ability and overall grasp of the candidate's over English language.
- 5. Simple Arithmetic: Number system, simplification, roots, averages, discounts, percentages, profit & loss, ration and proportion, partnership, chain rule, time * work, time & distance, simple & compound interest, mensuration, permutations & combinations, heights & distances, line graphs, bar graphs, pie charts and tabulation.
- 6. Basic Computer knowledge: Introduction to Computers, introduction to Graphical user interface based Operating System, elements or Word Processing, Spreadsheets, Power point presentations, Computer communication and internet, world wide web and web browser, communication and collaboration.
